

MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMS

To apply for a master's program, you must provide proof of a completed bachelor's degree that is recognized by the ZAB. The following master's degrees are available at EHB:

Social Work Counseling, M.A.

6 semesters, begins in the winter semester; consecutive, part-time study (attendance study)

Health/Nursing – Vocational Education, M.A.

4 semesters, beginning winter semester; consecutive, part-time study (attendance study)

Protestant Religious and Community Education, M.A.

3 semesters, beginning in the summer semester; consecutive full-time attendance study program

Leadership-Education-Diversity, M.A.

3 semesters, beginning in the summer semester; consecutive full-time attendance study program

Special feature: Graduates of a bachelor's degree program with 180ETCS must obtain or acquire missing credit points through other qualification achievements.

Social Work as a Human Rights Profession Master of Social Work (MSW)

Part-time program in cooperation with the Alice Salomon University of Applied Sciences Berlin and the Catholic University of Applied Social Sciences Berlin.

You have fled to Germany, do not yet have German Citizenship, but you already want to continue your education and study? - it is possible with us!

Admission Requirements:

You need a recognized school leaving certificate. You can find out whether your degree needs to be recognized in Germany on the databank Anabin anabin.kmk.org

To apply for a bachelor's degree, you need a B2 German language certificate from the TestDaf-Institution, DSH or TELC. A C1 certificate must be submitted within the first year of study. We do NOT offer preparatory language courses.

To apply for a master's degree, you need to have already completed a bachelor's degree that is professionally equivalent to the master's degree you have chosen. The bachelor's degree must be recognized by the Zentralstelle für ausländisches Bildungswesen (ZAB)

The application for study programs in winter semester takes place in April/May and for the start in the summer semester you must apply already in December/January.

General information:

At EHB, the standard period of study is 7 semesters for Bachelor programs and between 3 and 6 semesters for Master programs. The semester fees at the EHB correspond to the standard of public universities; as a person with refugee status, you can apply for Bafög.

There is also a chance to apply as a guest student at EHB free of charge and attend individual courses. This allows you to test if your desired course suits you. The selected courses can be recognized during your eventual study at EHB if completed successfully.

Most of the study programs can also be studied part-time if desired and temporary childcare is available for student-parents.

BACHELOR-STUDIENGÄNGE

Social Work, B.A.

Start of study: summer and winter semester

Occupational fields of activity: The program qualifies students for careers in public or private sectors on youth and family welfare, adult education, Healthcare, and various other fields of social activity.

Protestant Religious Education & Deaconics, B.A.

Start of study: winter semester

Professional fields of activity: The bachelor's degree program qualifies students for community education work with all age groups in church congregations and trains other educational personnel. The major in diaconics combines training in a state-recognized social profession with a theological qualification.

Childhood Education, B.A.

Start of study: summer semester

Occupational fields: The study qualifies for activities around upbringing/education of children aged zero to twelve years.

Bachelor of Nursing, B.Sc.

Start of study: winter semester

Special feature: Generalist nursing degree program which, in addition to the academic degree (B. Sc.), leads to the professional qualification of nursing specialist based on the Nursing Profession Reform Act. The studies take place at the EHB, the practical training in facilities of selected cooperation partners.

Occupational fields: Nursing in inpatient and outpatient facilities and services. Participation in the coordination and management of health and nursing care, consulting, etc. The Bachelor of Science degree corresponds to international standards and enables you to work abroad.

Midwifery, B.Sc. in Midwifery

Start of study: winter semester

Special feature: The study program is conducted in cooperation with numerous practical institutions in clinical and out-of-hospital obstetrics. Theoretical and practical teaching/learning events take place at the EHB. Theoretical knowledge is practiced in exercises in the newly established SkillsLab (practice rooms) at the EHB.

Occupational fields of activity: Care, support and counseling of pregnant women, women in childbirth and young families; as an employee in inpatient and outpatient facilities, as a self-employed freelancer (practice, birth center).
